Red Firecracker, Green Firecracker

Soundstage Ride

Attraction Type: Indoor Simulator Film Ride

Attraction experience is similar to: Disney's *Star Tours*, or Universal Studios *Back to the Future* ride but uses a soundstage context with sets from the firecracker factory in the film ***Red Firecracker, Green Firecracker***.

Capacity: 240 per show, 1440 per hour

Duration: 10 minutes

Visitor Experience: Prepare to be pulled into the heart of all out adventure. But beware! Things may just get a little explosive when a stunt monkey from another film set gets loose during our visit to a soundstage filming the sequel to the classic China Western Film – *Red Firecracker, Green Firecracker*.

Characters: Tour Guide, Monkey Handler, and Stunt Monkey

Other characters and equipment will represent the different film crew and situations typically found on a major special effects set.

Premise: We are on a tram tour visiting a soundstage shooting a sequel to the film *Red Firecracker, Green Firecracker*. It is our Tour Guide's first day on the job - and probably his last - as he wreaks havoc by setting a Stunt Monkey loose. In order to chase the Stunt Monkey down, the Monkey Wrangler pushes the Tour Guide aside and commandeers the tram. We then crash about the soundstage as the Tour Guide tries valiantly to continue giving us his tour. The ride is both funny and exciting for the audience.

Setting: A soundstage is the setting for the action in the simulator film. It is set-up as a fireworks factory shooting a sequel to *Red Firecracker, Green Firecracker*. Throughout the soundstage are all the people, props, sets

and equipment required for the shooting of a major special effects scene in a movie.

Technology Summary: Visitors experience the action of a full motion ride along with high-resolution film technology as the story takes them on a comic journey through a sound stage full of special effects and pyrotechnics.

Technology Detail: The motion-base for each vehicle utilizes flight training simulator technology with 6-axis hydraulic actuators providing three axes of tilt and three axes of motion achieving full motion simulation. A 40-person capsule with an on-board high definition projection system is mounted on the 6-degree of freedom motion base. There are six individual capsules, each with separate, load/unload ramps and fail-safe control systems. Each capsule has on-board rear screen projection system, audio system, controls and automated props and show effects, all of which are pre-programmed to synchronize with the action and motion of the film.

Operations: At peak utilization this attraction will require 10 permanent working positions, 1 entrance queue position, 2 grouping dispatch positions, 6 capsule positions, and 1 unload/exit position. Daily maintenance will consist of safety inspection and adjustment of the hydraulic motion base system and load ramps, and projector alignment and balance.

Preshow:

In the preshow area, TV monitors play a brief behind-the-scenes video that sets up the story and success of the film *Red Firecracker, Green Firecracker*. Now, we lucky few are about to receive a special tour behind the scenes of filming on the sequel. We are loaded into the simulator theatre and take our seats. The film begins.

Act I

Our Tour Guide welcomes us to the soundstage but apologizes that we can't get too close or we'll interfere with the working crew. He tries to compensate by explaining all the crew and equipment moving past us, but it is all moving so fast he barely gets an explanation out before they are gone. Flustered, he increasingly begins to get in their way, and crew members and gear just push on past him as fast as they are able.

The Tour Guide stops by the Stunt Monkey who is leashed and sitting atop a cage. The Monkey Handler is nearby, but is engrossed in conversation and script consultation with a 2nd Assistant Director.

Our Tour Guide tries to explain the Stunt Monkey's costume, complete with its robot features, unfortunately in doing so, he accidentally sets it loose.

Act II

Now the big chase scene begins with the Monkey Handler driving the tram while the Tour Guide hangs on tightly. The Stunt Monkey leads us on a funny and exciting chase. As we weave, back and forth through the soundstage, up and down ramps and skidding and swerving around, set pieces, people, equipment, food, props, etc. come flying at us. The Tour Guide gets the worst of everything, but somehow manages to hang on. Twice they get close to capturing the Stunt Monkey, but inevitably, the bumbling Tour Guide causes the capture to fail.

Act III

For the finale, the Stunt Monkey sets off the fireworks and causes explosions. This causes even more havoc on the set as sparks and flames from the fireworks flash in our vision and the explosions rock us in our seats.

At last, the tram crashes into a pile of equipment and stops; we teeter slowly back and forth, as the Monkey Handler exits the tram and approaches the Stunt Monkey. He offers a banana and when the Stunt Monkey accepts, reattaches a leash. All is saved.

Our Tour Guide - covered with paint, food, make-up, powder burns, and ripped clothes - stands in front of the destroyed set, and thanks us kindly for making the soundstage tour part of our day. In the background, the Stunt Monkey quietly eats his banana while pieces of set and equipment continue to fall causing us to experience one last big bump before the tour comes to an end.
